<b>Provider Travel Costs</b>			
<p>MBC Nursing may claim travel cost for workers travelling to and from home-based appointments to deliver Core (Category 1 &amp; 4) supports. This includes the cost of staff members time and any additional costs such as mileage, parking fees and tolls. The non-labour costs will be claimed against the relevant support item in accordance with NDIS acceptable price limits and conditions outlined in the price guide.</p> <p>MBC Nursing may claim for activity-based travel costs associated with transporting participants to and from appointments or community-based activities. This includes the cost of staff members time, costs such as mileage, parking fees and tolls. The non-labour costs will be claimed against the relevant activity-based transport support item in accordance with NDIS acceptable price limits and conditions outlined in the price guide.</p> <p>MBC Nursing will charge for Provider Travel time only when:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• MBC Nursing has the agreement of the Customer in advance i.e., the Service Agreement outlines all maximum Provider Travel cost that may be charged.</li> <li>• The Support Catalogue indicates that MBC Nursing can claim for Provider Travel in respect to that support item.</li> </ul>			

- MBC Nursing is required to pay the worker delivering the support for the time they spent travelling because of the agreement under which the worker is employed.

MBC Nursing will not charge travel costs:

- For travel for the time that a Support Worker spends travelling from home to the workplace (to a first Customer appointment each day); or
- For travel from the workplace to home (the last customer appointment of the day).

Where a provider claims for travel time (labour costs) in respect of a support, then the maximum amount of travel time that they can claim for the time spent travelling to each participant (for each eligible worker) is 30 minutes in MMM1-3 areas and 60 minutes in MMM4-5 areas (Note: the relevant MMM classification, is the classification of the area where the participant is when the support is delivered. Which for most MBC Nursing serviced participants is MMM1-3 classified areas).
